The 2021 ANNUAL PARISH ASSEMBLY will take place on Tuesday 25th May 2021 at Barnham Community Hall at 6.30 p.m.

The **Annual Parish Assembly** is a feature unique to Parish and Town Councils as it must be held by law each year between 1st March and 1st June (Local Government Act (LGA) 1972 Schedule (Sch.) 12 section 14 (1)). It is a meeting for residents of the Parish and it is your opportunity to place matters on the agenda that you wish to raise and even vote on.

Whilst the meeting is not a meeting of the Parish Council, the Parish Council will call the meeting, put together an agenda, although that can be driven by suggestions from residents, and the Chair of the Council will look after the running of the meeting.

If no suggestions come for the agenda come from residents we will look to produce a 'Community after COVID' focus to the event.

There will also be an opportunity to meet and chat (socially distanced) with your Parish Councillors as part of the event, but unfortunately this year we will be unable to offer refreshments.

Also, if you run a local group and would like the opportunity to give a short presentation or update people on what you do then get in touch and we can add that to the agenda.
