#### 7. Introduction to ABE Community Land Trust from Mike Link

Mike Link, ABE Chairman presented the Aldingbourne, Barnham and Eastergate Community Land Trust (CLT). The key points of the presentation were:

- CLT's are not-for-profit community-led initiatives
- ABE CLT has been has been in operation for five years and is supported by the local parishes and Arun District Council
- The aim of the CLT is to allocate properties to people with strong local connections via a nomination scheme
- Through ABE 21 affordable homes were recently allocated to nominated people at the Woodgate housing development.
- The scheme could be enhanced by being aware of housing development proposals as soon as possible.

The item was reviewed and discussed by the committee, and the decision was made that committee members would respond to the survey.

# 9. Current and Potential Developments in the Parish – Update Reports

### 9.1 Barratt's update

No update from the development site. Chris Wells updated the committee that the A29 Northern realignment scheme was due to commence with the demolition of the former Fleuri nurseries and construction of the roundabout on Barnham Road. It was noted that the roundabout is positioned over the sewer that collapsed previously.

Sue Wallsgrove updated the committee that the building of the shop was now underway with five flats above.

# 10.2 Vehicle Activated Screen (VAS)

Report for April 2024

Total vehicles (from both units): 279,393 Average speed for all vehicles: 34.08mph

 Review of publicly available data sets in the local area for traffic and air quality monitoring

- Detailed analysis of data retrieved from BEPC VAS unit 2 and review of information that is not available with the existing set up
- Local communities that currently undertake Speedwatch activity and what the associated data possibilities are
- Discussion points for BEPC and how to move forward

The Assistant Clerk reported that ADC had taken delivery of the proposed 'litter boxes' and were seeking advice as to where these should be placed around the parish. This was discussed by the committee and it was determined that further evaluation was required.
