### 13. Arun District Council's HELAA (Housing and Economic Land Availability Assessment)

The Assistant Clerk reported that following the inclusion on the 2025 HELAA, a response from ADC from Arun District Council had been received on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> July which stated that Murrell's Field had been classified on the HELAA database as 'Not Currently Developable'. This was due to the current lease situation and the fact that it was Local Green Space.
