This is the first house listed and although not mentioned in the memoir, it was indeed there in 1910. It has been demolished and replaced with flats and houses.

No name but property described as 'bungalow and garden'	Mary Bradshaw	Miss M Claydon, Perry Hill Farm, Worplesdon, Surrey	It is not clear if this is Kingsley (Langley House) or Ingleton or an earlier property. An Abstract of Title for Ellesmere shows this property in the name of a Mrs M. Clayton. Mary Bradshaw is renting this property in 1910, not Moreton.
